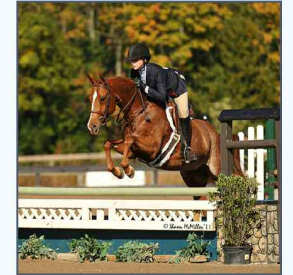

Entries must be declared the day before by the end of the day. (Guaranteed payback with 12 entries). To be eligible, you must enter in the respective division. Child/Adult and Jr/Amt Prix may be combined if section does not meet the required number of entries.

**Class 403. \$500 Hunter Derby - Fences 2'6"**

Open to both horses and ponies. Horse, owner, rider must be a PSJ member. Professionals may not compete. Same horse and rider combination may not compete over 3' at the same show. Riders showing more than one horse at the 3'6" level or over at the same show are not eligible. Course to be set on the 12' stride. No in and out. Two round format with the first round to be typical hunter classic course and the second round to include "handy" type questions. **12 Required to Fill.**

Entry Fee: \$35  
Prize Money: 150, 125, 100, 50, 45, 30

**Negative Coggins Required.**

**ACTS OF DISCOURTESY**

Any act of discourtesy to the judges or to any official of the show on the part of any owner, trainer, rider or groom will disqualify any horse with which they are associated and no refund will be made.

**ADD BACK JUMPERS**

Paid back to top six places. Breakdown as follows: 30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 10%, 5%. If there are less than six horses in a class, the entry fee drops to \$20.00 with no prize money paid back.

**ADD/SCRATCH**

No slip, no trip. If you are not on the class sheet, you must add in the show office and bring the slip to the ingate. If you are scratching, you must also do this in the show office and bring your slip to the ingate. No adds on Sunday.

**ATTIRE**

Jackets will be worn for the hunter and equitation classes in the show rings. Rider will be allowed to show in tucked in polo shirts in the jumper ring. The classics and mini-prix require formal attire.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS**

The legend "US Fund" must be pre-printed on the face of all Canadian checks drawn on Canadian banks used to pay entry fees.

**CHAMPION & RESERVE AWARDS**

Divisions with 3 or more entries are eligible for Champion and Reserve Champion awards. Points for the top 4 riders over fences will be combined with their Under Saddle points and the rider with the most points will be awarded the Championship, with the second highest point winner receiving the Reserve Championship. In the case of a tie, the rider with the most points over fences will receive the Championship.

**DOGS**

All dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds. Unrestrained dogs create a serious safety hazard for exhibitors and their horses. Loose dogs will not be tolerated in the show ring area. **They will be impounded and the owner will be charged a \$100 fine** added to their entry fee which will be donated to the SPCA.

**ELECTRICAL/FIRE REGULATIONS**

All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisles shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No class I Flammable liquids, such as gasoline, are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the Horse Show without recourse.

**FARRIER/VETERINARIAN/PHOTOGRAPHER**

No farrier/veterinarian/photographer other than those contracted with the official competition will be permitted to practice on the grounds without express permission of the management. Exhibitors wishing to use another farrier/veterinarian/photographer must request a permit at the Horse Show Office.

**FOOD**

Food service will be available on the grounds beginning the day of the show through Sunday.

**FOREIGN EXHIBITORS**

The legend "US Fund" must be pre-printed on the face of all Canadian checks drawn on Canadian banks used to pay entry fees.

**HORSE WELFARE**

**Horses and ponies may not enter more than 7 classes over fences, including equitation and all special classes, per day.**

**JUMP ORDER AND CONFLICTS**

A rotating jump order will, at management's discretion, be established for any jumping class. The starter must be advised by exhibitors of any conflicts to make necessary adjustments. **A 3 minute time may be called by management.**

**LUNGING**

**No lunging permitted in the show rings.** Lunging only in designated areas.

**MINOR EXHIBITORS**

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. Signatures of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES/GOLF CARTS**

Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles, ATVs, motorcycles, golf carts, etc. on the show grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show.

**ORDER OF GO**

Will be posted one hour prior to the start of the class.

**POLING AND OFFSETS**

Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited for all horses competing. Any rider, trainer, groom, or any other person who is in violation of the rules set forth above will be fined \$500 for each incident and may be suspended from further competition for the duration of the scheduled competition starting from the time of the incident. Any horse upon which a violation of the manual poling and/or use of bamboo offsets rules is perpetrated will be suspended from competition for the duration of the scheduled competition. All entry fees for the classes entered during the suspended period of the horse in question will be forfeited.

**PONY DISTANCES - Will be run according to size of the pony.**

**PRIZE MONEY**

The owner of any horse or pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded MUST provide a Social Security or Federal ID number on the entry. Foreign Exhibitors must fill out a W-8ECI or W-8BEN form prior to receiving any winnings. Prize money will be applied as a credit on your account at the show office. Checks will be mailed within 30 days after the show.

**PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR**

Everyone must wear properly fitting ASTM protective headgear with harness secured and properly fitted while riding in the designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitors to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

**SCHOOLING**

Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. **There will be a \$100 fine for anyone caught in the rings before or after the show if rings have been closed.** Rings will be available for schooling after the show each day. Closing times will be announced each day. The rings will be available for **hacking only** in the mornings. **No morning schooling.**

**TICKETED WARM-UP (WHEN AVAILABLE)**

Tickets are \$10.00 per ticket and should be purchased in the horse show office and are good for one round of eight jumps. Tickets are NOT refundable.

**TIES**

All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided by time, unless otherwise stated.

**TIME ALLOWED**

The time allowed is based on minimum of 382 yards per minute for all sections. **45 SECOND CLOCK** Will be in effect in all jumper classes.



## Rules & Regulations

The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations or PSJ Rules listed on our website shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final. The Horse Show Management reserve to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges, to change specifications in jumper classes as competitions warrants.

Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the Show Management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause.

### ENTRIES

Closing dates for stalls and entries is on entry blank:

**After this date there will be a \$15.00 late fee.**

Numbers will not be issued without a **signed open check** lodged with the horse show secretary.

The entry form must include:

- Horses' name & complete description.
- All classes or divisions entered.
- Social Security or Federal ID number of owner.
- Organization membership numbers.
- All mandatory signatures, including legal guardian in the case of a minor exhibiting.

### STABLING

Stall reservations must be guaranteed with a check. Stabling will be available the day before the show. Stalls are available **first come, first served**. Reserve stalls early! **Stalls are \$65 per weekend**. For reservations, please call **803.649.3505** or e-mail **psjshows@aol.com**. **STALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.**

### CHECK OUT

Any horse show bills not checked out at the conclusion of each show will be assessed a **\$50.00 FEE** for check out. Any mistakes at check out must be resolved within 24 hours. Check your bills carefully.

### COMPETITION OFFICE HOURS

Competition days - Opens one hour before the start of the first class and closes 30 minutes following the last class. Non Competition days - 12 p.m. to 5 p.m.

### DAMAGE

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly. (This includes screw eyes or nails in stalls.)

### DAY EXHIBITORS/NON STABLING

Horses entered but not stabled must use the designated area for day exhibitors. \$15.00 grounds fee per horse per day and a \$15.00 service fee per horse per show.

### FEED AND BEDDING

Hay, grain and bedding may be purchased on the grounds. For same day delivery, orders must be received prior to 12 noon. No Sunday deliveries. For feed and bedding reservations prior to arrival, please call (803.649.3505) fax (803.649.3577) or e-mail **psjshows@aol.com**. Deliveries other than that made through the horse show office are not permitted. You may bring your own.

### NON NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50 or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including the penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail service is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

### NON SHOWING HORSE

All non showing horses must have a signed entry blank in the office, \$30.00 non showing fee and \$15.00 service fee per horse per show.

### PADDOCKS - \$75/Show

### PARKING

**Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans and campers from being parked in the stable areas. Vans and trailers will be allowed in the stable area only to load or unload. PARKING AREAS WILL BE DESIGNATED AND VIOLATORS WILL BE TOWED AWAY AT OWNER'S EXPENSE AND FINED \$100.**

### REFUNDS

Full refunds will be given before the closing date of the stalls. **After the closing date of stalls, stall fees are not refundable.** After the show starts, with the official vet's certificate only, refunds will be given minus the stabling fee and a \$25.00 scratch fee and fees for classes already held prior to notification of horse show secretary, whether exhibited or not. Scratches must be made in the horse show office on the official form. Refunds will be mailed within 30 days after the horse show.

### RV HOOK-UPS

First come, first served, \$65 per show. No nightly rates.

### SERVICE FEE

All horses, showing or non showing, will be assessed a fee of \$15.00. This fee allows the horse UNLIMITED add/scratches from classes, access to schooling areas and rings at designated time and defers all charges for parking passes.

### SPLITTING OF TACK STALLS

The horse show office will split the tack stalls per the Trainers instructions among his/her customers up to each Saturday at 12:00 noon. At that point, the total amount will be billed to the trainers barn account.

# Equitation Medal Class Descriptions

## PSJ Medal Classes

**83., 183. PSJ Pony Medal Sm - 2', Med - 2'3", Lrg - 2'9"**

**84., 184. PSJ Junior Medal 3'**

**85., 185. PSJ Adult Medal 2'9"**

Open to Junior Riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday, except for Adult Medal. To be shown over a course of not less than eight obstacles which must include one combination including an oxer and two changes of lead after the first obstacle. A test may be included in the initial round or at the judge's discretion additional testing on the flat may be used for Pony Medal, tests 1-18 for Junior and Adult and will count 25%. Any exhibitor who does not participate in the testing is placed last of those exhibitors called back to test. Only one rider per horse/pony. To fill a class, three competitors must complete the course. *Must be a member.*

## SCHJA Medal Classes

**87., 187. Palmetto Pony Medal Sm - 2', Med - 2'3", Lrg 2'9"**

Open to Junior riders who are members of the SCHJA. Ponies to jump 2' for Sm, 2'3" for Med, 2'9" for Lrg over a modified hunter course. Only one rider per pony. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse or pony. Three (3) riders needed to fill the class. One fourth of the exhibitors, or no less than 2 exhibitors, must return for flat work. The flat work shall count 25%.

**86., 186. Palmetto Horse Medal Class 3'**

Open to Junior riders who are members of the SCHJA. Junior Horses to jump 3' over a modified hunter course. Only one rider per horse or pony. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of the horse or pony. Three (3) riders needed to fill the class. One fourth of the exhibitors, or no less than 2 exhibitors, must return for flat work. The flat work shall count 25%.

**Palmetto Adult Class 2'9"**

Open to Senior members of the SCHJA, to run in conjunction with Adult Equitation classes at rated shows. The top 15 riders who accumulate the most points in the Adult Equitation Division by Year-End will be invited to compete in the Palmetto Adult Medal finals at the Palmetto Finals Year End Horse Show.

## NCHJA Medal Classes

**88., 188. NCHJA Children's Medal Class 2'9"**

**89., 189. NCHJA Adult Equitation Class 2'9"**

**90., 190. NCHJA Pony Equitation Class 2'3, 2'9"**

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur Members of the NCHJA. To be shown over a hunter type course of not less than eight fences and one-third of the obstacles must be oxers. Horses to jump 2'9". Small/Medium Ponies jump 2'3"; Large Ponies jump 2'9". Only one rider per horse or pony. Four competitors to fill the class. Three competitors must complete the course. Judges may ask riders to perform USEF tests 1-19, for ponies USEF tests 1-9. The NCHJA Children's Equitation Class may be combined with the NCHJA Adult Equitation Class if there are less than 4 entries. *Must be a member.*

## BRHJA Medal Classes

**91., 191. BRHJA Junior Medal Class 2'6", 3'**

**97., 197. BRHJA Adult Medal Class 2'6"**

Open to all BRHJA Junior and Adult Amateur members. Fences shall be set at 2'6" for ponies and riders 12 years and under. Fences for horses and riders 13-17 shall be set at 3'. There shall be two divisions, one for fences to be set at 2'6" and another for fences set at 3'. Fences for the BRHJA Adult Medal Class will be set at 2'6". The top six (6) riders over fences shall return to be judged on the flat. Jumping portion shall count 70%, flat portion to count 30%.

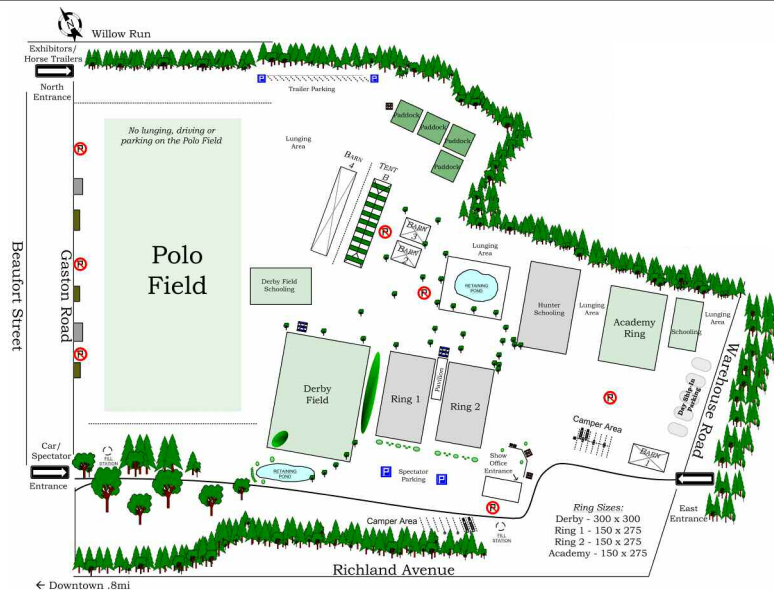
