
For each of the last ninety-seven years, horsemen and women have come to Blowing Rock for the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show making us the oldest continuous horse show in America Our shows this year will take place, July 21-26 (World Champion Hunter Rider week) and July 29-August 2. In these trying times, we look forward to gathering with our friends and enjoying this great tradition in the North Carolina mountains. We will be working with the USEF, the state of North Carolina and the village of Blowing Rock with guidance from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local public health entities to make sure that our exhibitors, staff and community stay safe.

We are very pleased that Wells Fargo Private Bank will be returning as a presenting sponsor of the Peak Of Excellence Rider Rewards. The daily high score hunter round in each ring will win \$500 with the winning groom receiving a \$100 bonus. The leading jumper riders, determined by cumulative prize money won over the two weeks, will receive cash awards as well: \$1,000 for the leading money winner Open Rider (Welcome and Classics), \$500 for the leading money winner in the Junior/Amateur Division (Division and Classics), \$500 for the leading Children's Jumper (Division and Classics), \$500 for the leading money winner Adult Jumper (Division and Classics). We will also offer the \$5,000 Pinnacle of Excellence Reward for the barn who receives the most Rider Rewards (professional and non-professional) over the two weeks. This year, we will again reward the owner of the horse(s) who wins the most Rider Rewards over the two weeks with \$5,000 donation to the 501(c)(3) charity of their choice.

Our horse show serves as the primary fundraising effort for the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show Foundation. The Foundation was established in 1999, and received 501(c)(3) organizational status from the Internal Revenue Service with the goal of continuing the support given to local non-profit emergency healthcare services in the area, animal welfare organizations, and promoting equestrian sports, education, and recreation in the North Carolina Mountains.

Proceeds from the show have been used to support local emergency healthcare organizations in the High Country, such as the Blowing Rock Fire Department and Rescue Squad. Through the Blue Ridge Parkway Foundation, the horse show has contributed to the preservation and maintenance of the carriage trails for equestrian access in the Moses H. Cone National Park, which adjoins the L.M. Tate Show Grounds in Broyhill Park. We are happy to serve as a gateway for thousands of horse enthusiasts to the twenty-six miles of trails in the Cone Estate. Our organization is also committed to animal welfare, supporting the Watauga County Humane Society, Horse Helpers, the AHJF Equine Relief Fund and Saddlebred Rescue. We are also happy to support the Appalachian State University Equestrian Team. Please let us know if you would like sponsorship information. We need all the help we can get!!





- 22. No lunging will be allowed in any ring.
- 23. Horse Show Management will designate "no-parking" areas and manure disposal areas. These must be adhered to strictly due to space limitations on the horse show grounds.
- 24. All exhibitors must close their account before the close of the show on each Sunday afternoon. Those in violation will be fined \$50, which will be given to the show beneficiary.
- 25. In order to compete, horses may not be poled and/or offsets used anytime while on the show grounds both before or during the show.
- 26. Secure, offsite parking for vans and trailers will be provided and required due to space limitations at the grounds. No exceptions. Those in violation will be fined \$100, which will be given to the show beneficiary.
- 28. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, all exhibitors in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing & Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness secured while riding anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.
- 29. MINOR EXHIBITORS: Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or LEGAL guardian. The signature of unrelated persons WILL NOT be accepted.
- Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder


- of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- FOOTING: Screenings will be used all areas. Competition rings will be no less than 250' x 130'.
- 32. FARRIER: No farrier other than the official competition farrier will be permitted to shoe on the grounds without express permission of the management. Exhibitors wishing to use another farrier must request a permission for that farrier at the Horse Show office.
- 33. VETERINARIAN: No veterinarian other than the official veterinarian will be permitted to practice on the show grounds. Exhibitors wishing to use their own veterinarian must request a permission for that veterinarian at the horse show office.
- 34. CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: The legend "US Funds" must be pre-printed on the face of all Canadian checks drawn on Canadian banks used to pay entry fees.
- 35. The Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show Foundation, Inc., Progressive Show Jumping, Inc., or any employees of same shall in no way, jointly or individually, be responsible for any loss, accident, damage, or loss of life that may occur to any exhibitor, trainer, agent, owner, groom, stable, corporation, partnership, individual, or spectator sustained while at the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show. This shall be incorporated as a condition of entry to the Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show.
- 36. Add/Scratch: No slip, No trip. If you are not on the class sheet, you must add in the show office and bring the slip to the ingate. If you are scratching, you must also do this in the show office and bring your slip to the ingate. No adds on Sunday.
- 37. Horse Show check non-negotiable 30 days after the show closes.
- 38. Returned check fee \$50.00 or 10% of the check, whichever is greater.
- 39. Hunter Prize Money: 1st 30%, 2nd 22%, 3rd 15%, 4th 13%, 5th 10%, 6th 10% \$1500.00 divisions the stake pm is \$500.00, \$2500.00 divisions the stake pm is \$900.00, \$3,000.00 divisions the stake pm is \$1100.00
- 40. This show is sanctioned in zone 3 and will follow their rules specifications as stated here:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF, NCHJA, GHJA, SCHJA, and VHSA rule books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The USEF protest fee is \$200.00 if made by a member or \$300 if made by a non-member
- All entries must be made on the regular printed form. The word "Entry" will not be accepted.
 Entry blanks must be complete with all information and appropriate areas signed before any number is issued.
- 3. Entries must be received by: June 29 Stall refunds until June 8th ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED. A late fee of \$50 will be charged for each entry received after the closing date of entries.
- 4. No stalls will be assigned until fees are paid. There are 442 permanent stalls, all others will be vinyl temporary stalls with doors.\$250.00 each per show. Stalls will be available Sunday, July 19th for the first week.
- 5. Horses entered in the show but not stabled on the grounds will be charged a \$50 grounds fee.
- 6. North Carolina requires a negative "Coggins" certificate, within 12 months of entering or leaving the state.
- 7. No initial bedding will be provided. Bag shavings will be available for purchase. Advance orders may be emailed: brepoffice@yahoo.com the form provided. Hay and grain will also be available. Bills for bedding and feed will be added to the exhibitor's horse show account and must be paid prior to departure from the horse show grounds.
- 8. A limited number of camper spaces will be available at \$300 per week. Please make reservations early. Electric golf carts are not permitted to be plugged in at any time in the camping area. Alternative camping grounds: Grandfather Mountain, Boone KOA, Secluded Valley RV, Green Mountain Park.
- 9. All entries in Pony Classes or Junior Hunter Classes must present a current Measurement Card or valid Measurement Form issued by the USEF before exhibitor number will be released. Measurement times must be arranged with the Steward and show veterinarian.
- 10. SCRATCHES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CONDITIONS WITHOUT A VETERINARIAN CERTIFICATE FROM THE SHOW VETERINARIAN.
- 11. The telephone number for the show veterinarian will be posted at the horse show office.

- 12. ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES IN THE INTEREST OF SAFETY. GUARD DOGS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE. A \$100 donation for all dogs caught loose in the rings and hospitality tent.
- 13. Prize money will be credited to exhibitors' horse show accounts. If the amount of prize money won exceeds the exhibitor's account, a check will be issued from the show office within 30 days after the show.
- 14. Jumping in the rings is not permitted in the mornings. Flat work only. Exhibitors violating this rule will be suspended from showing for 24 hours from the time of the infraction. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- 15. The Horse Show Committee reserves the right to:
- a. Refuse any or all entries, return money paid for stalls and entry fees without explanation or recourse to the show for liable compensation.
- Require all exhibitors to dress in proper riding attire, and as appropriate, including protective head gear.
- c. Combine or cancel classes with insufficient entries.
- d. Add to or vary the list of judges or officials.
- e. To eliminate from further competition or eject from the grounds any exhibitor, owner, or other individuals for any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges or officials.
- 16. In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the entry fee and/or stable charges WILL NOT be refunded. A charge of \$100.00 will be made for any horses stabled and not entered with the exception of a vet certificate.
- 16 A. Night watch \$15.00 per horse.
- 17. Should any question or dispute arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to Show Management, whose decision shall be final.
- 18. JUMPER DIVISION: Ties for places other than first shall be broken by the time taken during the first round.
- 19. Each horse will be charged a \$40.00 service fee.
- 20. No lunging will be allowed in any ring.
- 21. Exhibitors passes are required for entrance into the grounds during normal show hours. Passes are available in the Horse Show Office.

JUMPER DIVISION

NOMINATING FEE \$100: All horses showing in the Junior/Amateur Owner, Meter.30, Classics, and High Children's and Adult Jumper must be nominated and pay the nominating fee of \$100 by the closing date of the show. Once a horse is nominated, the nominating fee is NOT refundable.

(See rules and regulations for additional Jumper nomination information.)

DECLARATIONS

Declarations must be made on the appropriate form in the horse show office the day before the class is to be held by 4 PM or one hour after the last jumper class, whichever is later. Untimely declarations will be subject to jump first in the order of go.

TIME ALLOWED

The time allowed is based on a minimum of 382 yards per minute for all sections.

COURSES

Courses may consist of any combination of the following; brush, gates,

TIES

All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided by time, unless otherwise stated.

ORDER OF GO

Order of go will be posted one hour prior to the start of the class.

45 SECOND CLOCK

Will be in effect in all jumper classes.

POLING

Manual poling is prohibited for all horses on the grounds.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT






